We are actively involved in ministry in our local church and outside the local church as we travel regularly at weekends to minister in churches across the UK and Europe. Our heart is to raise up bold believers who go after Jesus and go after the lost. Fully surrendered to God!

I am passionate about being the hands and feet of Jesus in my community and wherever I work. For me it's not just talking the walk, but walking the talk. This is why I know that I am in the right place at the right time. Giving people hope and point them to the ONE (Jesus) who can give them a future to enjoy.

Good day to everyone. I am excited to introduce myself as the new chaplain for Greater Manchester Community Chaplaincy. At the time of writing this article, I have been working two months here at GMCC. I am settling in really well here. I work with a fantastic team of staff and volunteers. I would like to share my story with you.






I grew up in a beautiful countryside town in The Netherlands called Deurne which is in the province of North-Brabant, the South of the Netherlands. I have a half-brother and a stepsister whom I treat as my full brother and sister. I am incredibly grateful for them. I lost my biological mother when I was

2 years of age due to her taking her own life. She struggled with extreme mental health issues and couldn't cope with life anymore.

Growing up with my father and later with my stepmother, I was always full of questions in life about faith and God. At age 15 I made a decision to make Jesus Lord of my life. This was the start of the journey that would change

my life forever. You will be encouraged!

For the first years of my faith journey I saw God opening doors for me to go on various mission trips to different parts of the world to encourage, equip and empower the local church and reach out to those in need. I always had a passion for the less fortunate.
