
The Dangerous Message of the Gospel

One of the things that makes the message of the gospel good news is that when we realise we are sinners who cannot save ourselves we discover Jesus has done all that needs to be done for us to be accepted by God on the basis of faith alone. Paul goes so far as to



say in Romans 4:5 that God justifies the ungodly.

For many throughout history this has proved to be a far too dangerous message. It is true that from the start some have argued that being justified by faith alone means you can live as you want forgetting that if you have the real thing you will want to live a life that pleases God and reflects the character of Jesus. Paul wrote Romans Chapter 6 because of this very issue and it can be argued that unless we face the same accusation he deals with there we are not preaching the true gospel. But a far more dangerous thing is what



many well meaning people do thinking they are protecting the truth. They attach all kinds of THE MESSAGE conditions to the gospel so only those who have already OF THE CROSS changed can enjoy its benefits.
