Although we cannot replace the family that these precious people may or may not have or had we know that organisations like ours play a vital role in helping our people experience a bit of the magic of Christmas whether that is the trimmings that we have all become accustomed to or the infinitely more important cosmic significance of the real meaning of Christmas with our special services. God, coming as a baby to save all humanity.



As Christian charities we aim to reach the least, the last and the lost in different contexts. For us that is people who struggle with homelessness and for GMCC it is those who are in the prison system or who still live with the stigma of being ex-offenders. We understand that people need to know the hope of Jesus and even more so at Christmas time We will both be doing Christmas services and Christmas parties to ensure that our people are included in celebrating this season.


